Memory Screens

The ADRC of Racine County now provides Memory Screens to those over age 65, as part of an initiative to promote the early diagnosis of memory impairments. Note that we are not here to diagnose you, but rather to help provide a baseline of your memory or “cognition”, similar to having your blood pressure checked at a pharmacy.

Almost 50% of persons with dementia are never diagnosed or treated, but if diagnosed and treated early, the progression of dementia symptoms can be slowed. This could potentially lead to a better quality of life over time. The screens take approximately five minutes and are completely voluntary.

The results will be shared with you after they are calculated. If you would like we can also share the results with your physician or provide other referrals and general information on brain health.
